PLAQUE

In an effort to clarify by Board rule the established practice of the school district with regard to the procedure that is to be followed by plaque donors, it is recommended that the Board amend the referenced School Board rules.

Staff has advised that in the past the District has mandated strict adherence to regulations such as the measurements, materials and editorial content of plaques affixed to public school buildings. However, these requirements are not clearly or adequately incorporated in a School Board rule.

In taking the action as stated above the Board will clearly delineate by Board rule the practice of the Miami-Dade County Public Schools System with respect to plaque donors.
