DISTURBED STUDENTS**

This contract was awarded by the Board on September 13, 2000, and extended on May 15, 2001, and May 15, 2002, to obtain the professional services of one or more qualified psychiatrists, to provide on-site psychiatric consultation services, for the Office of Exceptional Student Education and Student Services.

Subsequent to the award, the awardee, Louis B. Antoine, M.D., of Pembroke Pines, Florida, has failed to perform in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract. Based on the failure of this vendor to perform, it is recommended that the award of this contract be terminated and that the vendor, Louis B. Antoine, M.D., lose eligibility to transact new business with the Board for a period of fourteen (14) months pursuant to Board Rule 6Gx13- 3C-1.08 - Performance and Payment Security, Declining A Bid Award, And Bonding Company Qualifications.

Consultation services for the six sites awarded to Dr. Antoine will be performed by the remaining awardee on this contract, Children's Psychiatric Center, Inc., of Miami, Florida.
