**SUBJECT:           AWARD BID NO. 023-CC04 – DISTRICT SOFTWARE  
LICENSING AND SPECIAL PURCHASE AGREEMENT**

The purpose of this bid, opened on March 13, 2003, is to establish a contract, with a maximum of two (2) vendors as providers/managers of software licensing agreements for comprehensive educational software, for various school locations, by the Division of Instructional Technology and Media Support Services. This is a term bid which states that the Board may purchase quantities, as may be required, at the unit price bid, but is not obligated to purchase any guaranteed amount. The evaluation criteria were based on ninety percent (90%) usage of Microsoft licenses, an assortment of the most popular educational titles and included the accessibility of a web-site for use by school locations. Of 612 vendors sent bid forms or card notices of this advertised bid, 23 responded, with 7 bids meeting specifications, 9 bids not meeting specifications (only bid on individual items, not all items) and 7 no bids.
