The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, announced on March 12, 2003, its intention to amend School Board Rules 6Gx13- 6A-1.02, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar, and 6Gx13- 6C-1.02, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar, for the 2003-2004 school year, at its meeting of May 14, 2003.

The Notice of Intended Action was published in the *Miami Daily Business Review* on March 17, 2003, posted in various places for public information, and mailed to various organizations representing persons affected by the amended rules and to individuals requesting notification.

The time to request a hearing or protest the adoption of these rules has elapsed.

In accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedures Act, these rules are presented to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, for adoption and authorization to file the rules in the official records of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

## NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION

THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, announced on March 12, 2003, its intention to amend Board Rules 6Gx13- 6A-1.02, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar - 2002-2003, and 6Gx13- 6C-1.02, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar, 2002-2003, at its meeting of May 14, 2003.

**PURPOSE AND EFFECT:** To amend the Elementary and Secondary School Calendar and the Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar for the 2003-2004 school year.

**SUMMARY:** Establishes school calendars for the 2003-2004 school year, designating days when students and teachers are in school, beginning and ending dates of grading periods, and holidays for students and employees.
