**SUBJECT: EXTEND CONTRACT NO. 158-AA10 – WATER TREATMENT
AND CHEMICAL CONSULTANT SERVICES FOR MIAMI-DADE
COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

COMMITTEE: BUSINESS AND FINANCIAL SERVICES

The purpose of the Request For Proposals, opened on April 5, 2001, was to establish a contract, at a firm price, to provide water treatment and chemical consultant services, for Maintenance. The terms of agreement, as contained in the contract, awarded by the Board on May 16, 2001, and extended on May 15, 2002, provided, that by mutual agreement between the successful vendor and The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, the contract may be extended for two (2) additional one (1) year periods. The contract is currently in its first extension period. The awardee has agreed to extend for the second one (1) year extension period, by letter, on file. It is considered to be in the best interest of the Board to extend this contract, for an additional one (1) year period, at the current prices, to benefit from fixed prices, during the next twelve (12) months, inasmuch as the Consumer Price Index (CPI), as of February 2003, indicated an increase of 3.0%.
