**SUBJECT: EXTEND CONTRACT NO. 080-BB10 - PROVIDE
 HYPERTENSION SCREENING FOR GRADE TEN STUDENTS**

COMMITTEE: BUSINESS AND FINANCIAL SERVICES

The purpose of the Request For Proposals, opened on March 26, 2002, was to establish a contract, at a firm unit price, to obtain the professional services of qualified agencies, to provide hypertension-screening services to grade ten students, for the Department of Comprehensive Health Services. The terms of agreement, as contained in the contract, awarded by the Board on May 15, 2002, provided, that by mutual agreement between the successful vendor and The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, the contract may be extended for two (2) additional one (1) year periods. The contract is currently in its initial year. The awardee has agreed to extend for the first one (1) year extension period, by letter, on file. It is considered to be in the best interest of the Board to extend this contract, for an additional (1) one year period, at the current prices, to benefit from fixed prices, during the next twelve (12) months, inasmuch as the Consumer Price Index (CPI), for medical care, as of February 2003, indicated an increase of 4.5%.
