**SUBJECT:           REQUEST AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT TO  
ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE  
EXCEPTIONAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION OF SOUTH  
FLORIDA TO PROVIDE EDUCATIONAL AND RELATED SERVICES  
FOR EXCEPTIONAL STUDENTS**

**COMMITTEE:       EDUCATION AND SCHOOL OPERATIONS**

Authorization is requested for the Superintendent to enter into a contractual agreement with the Exceptional Development Corporation of South Florida to provide vocational training and employment to individuals with disabilities. The agency will provide educational and related services in comprehensive on-the-job training programs for exceptional students, ages 18-22. Participation in these programs will provide students with an age-appropriate environment and the support necessary for making the transition from school-to-work upon leaving Miami-Dade County Public Schools. This facility is located at 991 NW 54<sup>th</sup> Street, Miami, Florida.

Funding for this contract will be provided, at least in part, by FTE generated from the Florida Education Finance Program. Extended School Year services, if required, will be provided through the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act. The proposed contract has been developed to provide services for a maximum of 25 students based on their current Individual Educational Plans (IEPs) and on their current matrix funding levels, in an amount not to exceed \$236,960, effective July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004.

The President of the Exceptional Development Corporation of South Florida is Mr. Michael Faine.

The appropriation for this item is included in the General Fund of the 2003-2004 Tentative Budget to be recommended for adoption in July 2003 under Fund 0100, Function 5217, Program 6840, Object 5310, Location 9731, and in the Contracted Programs Fund under Fund 0420, Function 5200, Program 3531, Object 5310, Location 9615.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to enter into a contractual agreement with the Exceptional Development Corporation of South Florida, to provide educational and related services for exceptional students, in an amount not to exceed \$236,960, effective July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004.
