REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT GRANT AWARDS FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING THE FLORIDA MENTOR TEACHER SCHOOL PILOT PROGRAM AND ENTER INTO SEPARATE CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS WITH DOWNTOWN MIAMI, NORTH COUNTY, AND RYDER ELEMENTARY CHARTER SCHOOL

EDUCATION AND SCHOOL OPERATIONS

The Florida Department of Education (FDOE), in partnership with the Milken Family Foundation, established the Florida Mentor Teacher School Pilot Program, a grant initiative designed to reward excellence in teaching.

The goal is to implement a five-step career ladder that gives outstanding teachers recognition and higher salaries. This year will be the third year in which Ryder Elementary Charter School has received grant funds from the FDOE under this grant initiative. North County and Downtown Miami Charter Schools will implement the first year of their projects.

In accordance with the FDOE grant guidelines for the Florida Mentor Teacher School Pilot Program, Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) must be the fiscal agent on behalf of charter schools that receive such grants. The Board's approval of the recommended action would not constitute an endorsement of the grant or its intended use. It would merely satisfy the Board's requirement under Florida Statutes, Section 1002.33, Charter Schools, which requires that M-DCPS monitor the revenues and expenditures of the Charter School(s).

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive the grant funding. Grant funds in the total amount of \$450,000 will be distributed in equal amounts of \$150,000 as separate contractual agreements among the three schools:

Ryder Elementary Charter School	150,000

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Official notification of these grant awards was received on August 4, 2003, which is after the start of the grant period. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective July 1, 2003.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept grant awards from the Florida Department of Education for funding the Florida Mentor Teacher School Pilot Program in the total amount of \$450,000 for the grant period of July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004;
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- 2. enter into separate contractual agreements with: Downtown Miami Charter School, in the amount of \$150,000; North County Charter School, in the amount of \$150,000; and Ryder Elementary Charter School, in the amount of \$150,000 for the contract period of July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004;
- 3. extend these programs and contractual agreements as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, in order to complete the goals of the program; and
- 4. direct Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
