REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR FUNDING THE READING COACHES MODEL GRANT

The Florida Department of Education (FDOE) has advised the Miami-Dade County Public Schools of the approval of the Reading Coaches Model grant application in support of the elementary, middle, and high schools that do not participate in the Reading-First Initiative with low-performing students in reading. A reading coach will be placed in each of the thirty-two schools that have received a grade of D by FDOE for at least two consecutive years. These coaches will serve as a resource for professional development, progress monitoring, and student data analysis throughout the school to generate improvement in reading achievement.

The Reading Coaches Model Grant Program will be funded through Specific Appropriation 69, General Revenue, in the amount of \$2,587,951.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive the grant funding. Grant funds in the amount of \$2,587,951 will support salaries and fringe benefits for the thirty-two reading coaches, travel to attend the required state-sponsored professional development, and supplies.

Official notification of this grant award was received on August 19, 2003, which is after the start of the period. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective July 1, 2003.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education for funding the Reading Coaches Model Grant Program in the amount of \$2,587,951 for the grant period of July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004;
- 2. extend this program as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, in order to complete the goals of the program; and
- 3. direct Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
