Approval is requested for Resolution No. 03-42 of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, proclaiming October 2003 as Computer Learning Month in Miami-Dade County Public Schools. Computer Learning Month is designed to focus attention on the important role computers, software, and other technologies play in the way teachers teach and the way students learn. Computer Learning Month is also a time to try new ways of using technology, to learn new technology products, and to share knowledge with others in our community.

The No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 calls for all eighth grade students to attain computer literacy by 2006. The Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) will support this national effort with a series of online activities and competitions that will be hosted on the M-DCPS Education Portal at http://portal.dadeschools.net. activities and competitions are designed to be easily integrated into the classroom and are focused on important topics related to technology. They involve student research, creativity, and communication. Teachers are encouraged to use the various technology resources on the Education Portal that are designed to impact student achievement and promote mastery of the Sunshine State Standards. The resources include quality assessment tools, research databases, lesson plans, online professional development opportunities, and interactive lessons in mathematics and science.

Additional events include the Enhancing Education Through Technology Leadership Symposium hosted by the Division of Instructional Technology and Media Support Services, on October 17, 2003.
