The Florida Learn and Serve America Grant Program is funded under the Corporation for National Service. The goal of the Program is to provide opportunities for students to apply academic skills to community service projects. All schools and district offices were invited to participate in this grant initiative.

The following schools have received funds for planning service-learning activities under this grant initiative:

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive the grant funding. Grant funds in the total amount of \$5,100 will be used for hourly salaries, fringe benefits, and travel for professional development.

Official notification of this grant award was received on August 26, 2003. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective September 1, 2003.

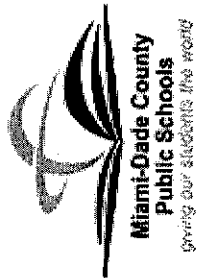
RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:
