The Florida Learn and Serve America Grant Program is funded under the Corporation for National Service. The goal of the Program is to provide opportunities for students to apply academic skills to community service projects. - accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education for funding the Florida Learn and Serve America Program in the amount of \$26,589 for the grant period of September 1, 2003 through August 31, 2004;
- 2. extend this program as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, in order to complete the goals of the program; and
- 3. direct Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
