COMMITTEE: EDUCATION AND SCHOOL OPERATIONS

The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, announced on August 20, 2003, its intention to amend School Board Rule 6Gx13- 5D-1.08, Maintenance of Appropriate Student Behavior, at the meeting of October 22, 2003, by updating the Code of Student Conduct — Elementary and Code of Student Conduct — Secondary. The amendment to the School Board Rule will revise the threshold for acceptable student behaviors, as established by Florida Statutes and State Board of Education rules. In addition, recommendations from the Code of Student Conduct Committee have been incorporated into this document.

The Notice of Intended Action was published in the *Miami Daily Business Review* on August 25, 2003, posted in various places for public information and mailed to various organizations representing persons affected by the amended rule and to individuals requesting notification.

The time to request a hearing or protest the adoption of this rule has elapsed.

In accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act, this amended rule is presented to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, for adoption and authorization to file the rule in the official records of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Attached are the Notice of Intended Action and the amended rule. Changes from the current rule are indicted by striking through words to be deleted and underscoring words to be added.

Copies of the documents, Conduct of Student Conduct – Elementary and the Code of Student Conduct – Secondary, which is incorporated by reference and is a part of this rule, will be forwarded to Board Members under separate cover and will be available for inspection by the public in the Office of Board Recording Secretary, Room 924, and the Citizen Information Center, Room 158, 1450 N.E. Second Avenue, Miami, Florida 33132, prior to the School Board Meeting of October 22, 2003.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, adopt amended School Board Rule 6Gx13- 5D-1.08, Maintenance of Appropriate Student Behavior, and the documents, Code of Student Conduct – Elementary and Code of Student Conduct - Secondary, which is incorporated by reference and is part of this rule, and authorize the Superintendent to file the rule with The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, to be effective October 22, 2003.

MAINTENANCE OF APPROPRIATE STUDENT BEHAVIOR

The schools are established for the benefit of all students. The educational purposes of the schools are accomplished best in a climate of student behavior that is socially acceptable and conducive to the learning and teaching process. Student behavior that disrupts this process or that infringes upon the rights of other individuals will not be tolerated. The School Board endorses a zero tolerance policy toward school related violent crime.

The School Board reaffirms its support of the administrative staff and teachers in taking all necessary steps to enforce and implement all School Board rules pertaining to the maintenance of appropriate student behavior. Important among these rules are those in the areas of conduct, corporal punishment, suspensions and expulsions, and climate for learning.

The School Board directs that:

- The Superintendent of Schools, through the Miami-Dade Schools
 Police Department shall pursue the investigation and assist in the
 subsequent prosecution of any adults inciting students to perform
 violent and unlawful acts in the schools; and
- Each individual teacher shall be granted full disciplinary authority over every student in his/her classroom, in accordance with Florida Statutes, Florida Board of Education rules, School Board rules, and administrative memoranda.
