The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, announced on September 10, 2003, its intention to amend School Board Rules 6Gx13- 6A-1.02, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar, and 6Gx13- 6C-1.02, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar, for the 2004-2005 school year, at its meeting of October 22, 2003.

The Notice of Intended Action was published in the *Miami Daily Business Review* on September 15, 2003, posted in various places for public information, and mailed to various organizations representing persons affected by the amended rules and to individuals requesting notification.

The time to request a hearing or protest the adoption of these rules has elapsed.

In accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedures Act, these rules are presented to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, for adoption and authorization to file the rules in the official records of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Attached are the Notice of Intended Action and the amended rules. Changes from the current rules are indicated by <u>underscoring</u> words to be added and striking through words to be deleted.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

- 1. adopt amended Board Rule 6Gx13- <u>6A-1.02</u>, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar;
- 2. adopt amended Board Rule 6Gx13- 6C-1.02, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar; and authorize the Superintendent to file the rules with The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, to be effective August 5, 2004.
