**SUBJECT: REQUEST SCHOOL BOARD DENIAL OF THE CHARTER SCHOOL
APPLICATION FOR INTERNET DATA ELECTRONIC ACADEMY, INC.,
ON BEHALF OF IDEA PREPARATORY**

COMMITTEE: EDUCATION AND SCHOOL OPERATIONS

As established in School Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.47, Charter Schools (K-12), Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) received charter school applications from individuals and/or organizations in the community.

On September 12, 2003, M-DCPS Charter School Technical Assistance Team reviewed the application for IDEA Preparatory and identified a number of concerns. On September 26, 2003, a second opportunity was provided to the applicant to address these concerns, and on October 1, 2003, a revised application was submitted to the district. The revised application was again reviewed by the members of the Technical Assistance Team who had initially identified the concerns; however, it was determined that the concerns had not been satisfactorily addressed.

On October 20, 2003, M-DCPS Charter School District Review Committee met to review the application for IDEA Preparatory and also determined that the concerns had not been satisfactorily addressed. As such, the application submitted by Internet Data Electronic Academy, Inc., on behalf of IDEA Preparatory is being recommended for denial at this time.

The following is the Founding Board for the charter school: Dr. Ralph McKinney Ross, Educator; Dr. Charles Williams, Jr., Educator; Mr. Robert Lee McKinney, Attorney; and Dr. Darryl Franklin Reaves, Businessperson and Educator.

Copies of the charter school application and the evaluators' votes will be submitted to the School Board Members under separate cover, and will be available for inspection in the Office of Board Recording Secretary and in the Citizen Information Center.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, deny the charter school application submitted by Internet Data Electronic Academy, Inc., on behalf of IDEA Preparatory.
