**SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD
FROM THE CORPORATION FOR PUBLIC BROADCASTING
FOR FUNDING THE TELEVISION COMMUNITY SERVICE
PROGRAM FOR WLRN-TV**

COMMITTEE: EDUCATION AND SCHOOL OPERATIONS

The Corporation for Public Broadcasting provided a Television Community Service Grant in the amount of \$1,006,336 to support day-to-day operations of WLRN-TV during 2002-2004. The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida is eligible for a Television Community Service Grant in the amount of \$1,006,697 for the 2003-2005 school years.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive the grant funding. Grant funds in the amount of \$1,006,697 will be used to support 17 full-time staff members and operations of WLRN-TV.

Official notification of this grant award was received on September 22, 2003. Reimbursement of grant related expenditures is authorized effective October 1, 2003.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting for funding under the Television Community Service Grant for WLRN-FM in the amount of \$1,006,697 for the grant period of October 1, 2003 through September 30, 2005;
2. extend this program as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, in order to complete the goals of the program; and
3. direct Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
