**SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF RESIGNATION
THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA V.
ALONSO L. LAW**

Mr. Alonso L. Law is a custodian at Norland Middle School who has substantiated charges that are in violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties, 6Gx13-4-1.08, Violence in the Workplace, 6Gx13-5D-1.07, and Corporal Punishment-Prohibited. The employee submitted his resignation effective December 10, 2003.

It is recommended that the resignation be accepted, in lieu of pending disciplinary action as achieving the objective sought by The School Board in this case. In accepting this resignation, the employee waives any hearing rights. The employee will remain employed until the end of the workday of December 10, 2003.

There is good cause to vary from the agenda because the employee can withdraw his resignation at any time prior to Board acceptance. This item does not appear in the published agenda.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida accept the resignation of Mr. Alonso L. Law, Custodian at Norland Middle School, effective as of the close of the workday on December 10, 2003.
