**SUBJECT: REQUEST APPROVAL OF SUPPLEMENTAL AWARDS ON TERM BIDS**

The purpose of this request is to obtain prior approval of the supplemental awards on the following term bids inasmuch as the estimated requirements, previously awarded by the Board, will be exceeded before the bids terms expire.

Bid No. 039-AA07 - INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY EDUCATIONAL EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES, CATALOG DISCOUNT, to establish a contract, to purchase, at firm unit prices, quantities, as may be required, of industrial technology educational equipment and supplies, for various schools and departments, during the term of the contract, effective February 14, 2003, through February 13, 2004. This supplemental award is requested due to unanticipated expenditures for opening of new schools. Last contract usage averaged \$82,153.45 per month, while this year's usage has averaged \$108,306 per month. In one month, three requisitions (Lamar Louise Curry Middle School) in the total amount of \$203,414 increased our average monthly expenditure 24%. Additional requests for Robert Morgan, Ferguson Senior High as well as other projects are anticipated from FF&E. The supplement amount requested is based on the average monthly expenditure, times twelve months contract period, plus 10% minus the original award amount.
