Authorization is requested for the Superintendent to enter into a contractual agreement with Citrus Health Network, Inc., for the 2005 summer services and the 2005-2006 school year. In compliance with Florida State Statutes 1006.07, the Office of Alternative Education, Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS), and Citrus Health Network, Inc., a nonprofit community based organization has developed a contractual agreement to provide educational and related services for at-risk school-age students. Supervision of these programs will be provided by the principal of the Educational Alternative Outreach Program. Contractual agreements with community based organizations have been in effect since 2003. } Revised

Funding figures are estimates and will be based upon actual revenue received by the District and the Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP). The program is funded yearly at 95 percent of the earned FTE. } Revised
