REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (FLDOE) FOR FUNDING UNDER THE NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND ACT OF 2001, TITLE X, PART A, EDUCATION FOR HOMELESS CHILDREN AND YOUTH PROGRAM EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2005, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2006

COMMITTEE: INSTRUCTIONAL EXCELLENCE AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Authorization is requested to accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE), in the amount of \$85,000, under the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, Title X, Part A, Education for Homeless Children and Youth Program (Stewart B. McKinney-Bruce Vento Homeless Assistance Act), for the grant period of July 1, 2005, through June 30, 2006. The goal of the program is to provide supplemental funding for school districts to ensure that homeless children and youth have equal access to the same free, appropriate public education, including preschool education, as provided to other children and youth. This grant will be managed by the Division of Student Services.

This grant provides funds for Project Up-Start which is in its 13th year of operation in Miami-Dade County Public Schools. Project Up-Start serves homeless children and youth by ensuring that homeless children are furnished with an after-school tutorial program. Tutoring is available at 14 shelters throughout Miami-Dade County. During the 2004-2005 school year, 1,855 students were served.

The project coordinator oversees districtwide services, such as school placement and registration for students, and provides homeless awareness activities for school-based personnel and community groups. In addition, Miami-Dade Transit Agency provides an in-kind contribution valued at approximately \$10,000, to supplement transportation services.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive the grant funding. Grant funds provide for a full-time social worker who serves as project coordinator, hourly tutors, and in-county travel.

Official notification of this grant award was received on November 1, 2005, which is after the start of the grant period. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective July 1, 2005.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE), for funding under the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, Title X, Part A, Education for Homeless Children and Youth Program, in the amount of \$85,000, for the grant period of July 1, 2005, through June 30, 2006;
- retain funds from the grant in an amount not to exceed the annually negotiated indirect cost rate, as allowed and approved by the FLDOE;
- 3. extend this program as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program; and
- 4. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
