Dr. Underwood is one of only five teachers in the nation to be inducted into the National Teachers Hall of Fame this year. He learned of this special honor at a surprise ceremony at Miami Senior High School on April 19, 2007.

Dr. Underwood has challenged students to realize that there is a champion in each of them. He has taught his students to excel in the classroom and on the playing field. He has received numerous awards for his contributions to education and is viewed as a leader and innovator at Miami Senior High School. Dr. Underwood continually prepares his students for the workforce, for college, and for life.
