Request For Proposals No. 055-GG10 – CAREER EDUCATION PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT, which opened on May 8, 2007, was to develop, coordinate, implement and monitor data-driven Career Education Programs that focus on improving and/or increasing students performance, knowledge or careers, job skills, personal interests, and level of readiness, for Specialized Programs – Schools of Choice. This program will assist students as they transition through K-12 grade levels and prepare to enter the workforce. Four (4) vendors responded to this advertised solicitation.

A meeting of the Selection Committee to evaluate the proposals was held on May 16, 2007. After considerable discussion, the committee determined that the specifications did not contain all the requirements for this program and recommended that all proposals be rejected, to permit rebidding, using revised specifications.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, **REJECT** Request For Proposal No. 055-GG10 – CAREER EDUCATION PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT, to permit rebidding, using revised specifications.
