Our audit report presents the results of our observations, analysis and year-end counts of the inventories corresponding to Textbook and Inventory Services, the Department of Food and Nutrition, Stores and Mail Distribution, Maintenance and Materials Management, and the Department of Transportation.

We concluded that year-end inventories totaling \$22.4 million were fairly stated in the Annual Financial Report. A minor downward adjustment of approximately 1% of the total value of the inventory relating to processed food commodities was required. The adjustment was not material to the financial statements.

Results also disclosed that, although the control environment was satisfactory in certain areas, some of the processes involved in the inventory reconciliations of Food and Nutrition and Transportation departments could be improved. At Stores and Mail Distribution, although the inventory was accurately reported, the cycle count process could be improved. The inventories corresponding to Textbooks and Maintenance and Materials Management proved fully satisfactory.

The School Board Audit Committee reviewed this report at its December 11, 2007 meeting and recommended transmitting it to the School Board.
