Section 1002.33(7), Florida Statutes, Charter Schools, stipulates that a charter school contractual agreement may be modified during its initial term or any renewal term upon the recommendation of the sponsor and the approval of both parties to the agreement.

The initial charter school contractual agreement for Mater Academy, Inc., on behalf of Mater Academy East Middle School (Mater East Middle) was approved by The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida (The School Board), on April 13, 2005, for a term of ten years, commencing with the 2005-2006 school year. A subsequent amendment was granted by The School Board, on June 14, 2006, to increase the grade level configuration.

Mater East Middle is currently located at 450 SW Fourth Street, Miami, Florida 33130, and serves approximately 157 students in grades six through nine. Mater East Middle has requested a second amendment to add an additional permanent site located at 998 SW First Street, Miami, Florida 33130, commencing with the 2008-2009 school year and throughout the term of the contract ending on June 30, 2015.

Mater East Middle is eligible to be graded under Florida's System of School Improvement and Accountability. Its academic performance is as follows:

Mater East Middle's audited financial statements revealed no inaccuracies, shortages, defalcations, fraud and/or violations of laws, rules, regulations and contractual provisions.

On May 22, 2008, the Contract Review Committee (CRC) met, and by a unanimous vote, made a recommendation for approval of the charter school contractual agreement with Mater Academy, Inc., on behalf of Mater Academy East Middle School.
