**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE FOUNDATION FOR THE NATIONAL INSTITUTES OF HEALTH TO RECEIVE FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE *I CAN DO IT, YOU CAN DO IT!* PROGRAM**

**STRATEGIC PLAN: IMPROVE RETURN ON INVESTMENT OF GRANT DOLLARS**

Authorization is requested to enter into a contractual agreement with the Foundation for the National Institutes of Health (FNIH), to receive funds in the approximate amount of \$60,000, for the grant period of September 1, 2008 through August 31, 2011. Funds will be distributed in the amount of \$20,000 per year over a three-year period. The purpose of this program is to enhance physical activity, good nutrition, fitness and healthy lifestyles in children and youth with disabilities. The program will be managed by the Division of Student Services and supports the District goal to ensure achievement of high academic standards by all students, by improving student health and wellness.

Funding for *I Can Do It, You Can Do It!* will provide children with disabilities with 30 minutes of activity per day, 5 days per week. The District's *I Can Do It, You Can Do It!* program was established in 2005 and was previously funded through grants from the United States Department of Health and Human Services and the Christopher Reeve Foundation.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive the grant award. Grant funds will be used for stipends, program and informational materials, adaptive equipment and usage fees, transportation, and incentives for participation. Indirect cost is not allowed.

Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective September 1, 2008.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. enter into a contractual agreement with the Foundation for the National Institutes of Health to receive funds to support the / *Can Do It, You Can Do It!* Program in the approximate amount of \$60,000, for the grant period of September 1, 2008, through August 31, 2011;
2. extend this program and contractual agreement as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program; and
3. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
