This item is submitted for consideration by the Board to amend School Board Rule 6Gx13- 5B-1.07, Student Records, and the document, Student Educational Records, incorporated therein by reference and made part of the rule. Proposed revisions to the Student Educational Records document are intended to bring the rule into compliance with recent legislative changes. In particular, in accordance with statutory guidelines, the amended document incorporates provisions aimed at facilitating access to student information for representatives from select agencies that directly support M-DCPS students and schools. The amended Student Educational Records document also includes the following proposed revisions:

- reclassification of the Record Access Card to Category A
  —Permanent Information;
- · redesigned Opt Out form; and
- streamlined opt out process with subsequent year carry over.

Attached are the Notice of Intended Action and the proposed amended rule. Changes from the current rule are indicated by <u>underscoring</u> words to be added and <del>striking through</del> words to be deleted.

## NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The purpose of the amendment is to incorporate recent legislative changes in the *Student Educational Records* document.

SUMMARY: The Student Educational Records document, which is incorporated in the rule by reference and is made part of the rule, has been amended to provide updated forms and procedures relating to the "Opt Out" process restricting release of directory information. In addition, the document reflects updated information relating to maintenance of permanent records and it incorporates a new section addressing access to student information for select agencies designated as "Other School Officials".

## STUDENT RECORDS

Records are necessary to facilitate the orderly educational progress of each student. The information contained in student records shall be limited to those data elements necessary for the making of educational decisions. Continued efforts shall be made to protect the accuracy and privacy of the information contained in student educational records.

In order to implement a student records system, the Superintendent of Schools shall have the responsibility for developing and issuing directives, consistent with the appropriate Federal and State Statutes pertaining to student records.

The document, **Student Educational Records**, shall contain the District's directives and procedures relative to that subject and is incorporated into this Board Rule. Copies of the document are on file for public reference in the Office of Board Recording Secretary, and the Citizen Information Center. Additionally, a copy shall be available at each ACCESS Regional Center for inspection.
