**SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT TWO GRANT AWARDS FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (FLDOE) FOR FUNDING UNDER THE FLORIDA COMMUNITY SERVICE GRANT PROGRAM FOR WLRN-FM AND WLRN-TV**

**COMMITTEE: INSTRUCTIONAL EXCELLENCE AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT**

**LINK TO DISTRICT STRATEGIC PLAN: IMPROVE RETURN ON INVESTMENT OF GRANT DOLLARS**

Authorization is requested to accept two grant awards from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) in the amount of \$610,050, to partially support day-to-day operations of WLRN-FM and WLRN-TV, for the grant period of July 1, 2008, through June 30, 2009. Under the 2008-2009 General Appropriations Act, Line Item 115, Catalog of State Financial Assistance #48.056, the Florida Legislature appropriated funding as follows:

Program	Grant Amount
Florida Community Service Radio Program	\$ 101,986
Florida Community Service Television Program	\$ 508,064
Total	\$ 610,050

All eligible public broadcasting stations throughout the state receive equal allocations. These grants will be managed by WLRN and support the Superintendent's initiative to actively engage family and community members.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive the grant funding. Grant funds will be used to partially support personnel and operations of WLRN-FM. Indirect cost is not allowed.

Official notifications of these grant awards are anticipated on or before September 10, 2008, which is after the start of the grant period. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective July 1, 2008.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept two grant awards from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the:
  - a. Florida Community Service Radio Program in the approximate amount of \$101,986, for the grant period of July 1, 2008, through June 30, 2009; and
  - b. Florida Community Service Television Program in the approximate amount of \$508,064, for the grant period of July 1, 2008, through June 30, 2009;
2. extend these programs as authorized through official notifications from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the programs; and
3. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.

**SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE FOUNDATION FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF CARDIAC THERAPIES, INC., TO PROVIDE THE HEALTHCORPS PROGRAM AT MIAMI CORAL PARK SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL**

**STRATEGIC PLAN: IMPROVE RETURN ON INVESTMENT OF GRANT DOLLARS**

Authorization is requested to enter into an Agreement with the Foundation for the Advancement of Cardiac Therapies, Inc. to provide the HealthCorps program at Miami Coral Park Senior High School during the 2008-2009 school year. HealthCorps, an in-school and after-school program that enables youth to make positive behavioral choices affecting their health, will be implemented by a staff person funded, hired and trained by HealthCorps, representing approximately \$75,000, of in-kind resources. Miami Coral Park Senior High School was identified by HealthCorps as an appropriate school for this pilot program.

HealthCorps, a proactive health movement founded by Dr. Mehmet Oz, aims to help stem the crisis of child obesity through school-based education and mentoring, as well as community events and outreach to underserved populations. Dr. Mehmet Oz is Vice Chairman of Surgery at Columbia University; Director of the Cardiovascular Institute at New York Presbyterian Hospital; and serves as the Chairman of HealthCorps. Modeled after the Peace Corps, the HealthCorps school-based program provides teens with practical life skills through fun and interactive school seminars focused on the value and power of students' bodies and minds.

There is no cost to Miami-Dade County Public Schools to enter into the Agreement and to accept implementation of the HealthCorps Program at Miami Coral Park Senior High School during the 2008-2009 school year.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. enter into an Agreement with the Foundation for the Advancement of Cardiac Therapies, Inc. to provide the HealthCorps Program, valued at approximately \$75,000, of in-kind resources, at Miami Coral Park Senior High School for the 2008-2009 school year; and
2. extend this Agreement as authorized through official notification for the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program.
3. There is no cost to Miami-Dade County Public Schools.
