**SUBJECT: THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA v. RENEE MEYERS - DOAH Case No. 08-4126**

On August 4, 2008, the School Board took action to suspend Renee Meyers, a teacher with Miami-Dade County Public Schools, for fifteen (15) workdays without pay. The charges included violations of School Board Rules 6Gx13- 4A-1.21, *Responsibilities and Duties* and 6Gx13- 4A-1.213 *Code of Ethics*. Ms. Meyers requested an administrative hearing, which was held on December 9, 2008, before Administrative Law Judge Patricia M. Hart. } Revised

By Recommended Order entered March 5, 2009, the Administrative Law Judge recommended that the School Board enter a final order finding that Ms. Meyers committed misconduct in office and suspending her without pay for a period of fifteen workdays. } Revised

A copy of the Recommended Order is being furnished to the Board under separate cover, along with a copy of the proposed Final Order for the Board's consideration.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida enter a Final Order accepting the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order in the case of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida v. Renee Meyers, DOAH Case No. 08-4126, suspending Respondent for fifteen (15) workdays without pay.
