Authorization is requested to accept three grant awards from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE), in the total amount of approximately \$669,000, to fund the Public Charter School Grant Program (Planning, Design and Implementation) for the Somerset Arts Academy in the amount of \$225,000, for the grant period of February 6, 2009 through September 30, 2009; Somerset Academy High School South Campus in the amount of \$202,000, for the grant period of March 6, 2009 through September 30, 2009; and Somerset Academy Middle School South Campus, in the amount of \$242,000, for the grant period of March 6, 2009, through September 30, 2009.

The FLDOE issued a Request for Applications under the Public Charter School Grant Program (Planning, Design and Implementation) for the purpose of awarding grants to charter schools partnering with local educational agencies in order to provide a high quality education for all students. Grant funds will be used to support planning, program design and implementation activities and to supplement the level of funds that would be made available from non-federal sources.

In accordance with the FLDOE grant guidelines, Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) must be the fiscal agent on behalf of each of the charter schools that receives such grants. The Board's approval of the recommended action would not constitute an endorsement of the grant or its intended use. It would merely satisfy the Board's requirement under Florida Statutes, Section 1002.33, Charter Schools, which requires that M-DCPS serve as the fiscal agent.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive the grant funding. Grant funds in the amount of \$660,000 will be distributed as follows:

Official notification of these grant awards was received on March 23, 2009, which is after the start of the grant periods. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective February 6, 2009 and March 6, 2009 for the respective grant programs.

RECOMMENDED:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept three grant awards from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the Public Charter School Grant Program (Planning, Design and Implementation) in the approximate amount of \$669,000;
- 2. disburse grant funds in the approximate amount of \$664,049 to Somerset Arts Academy, in the amount of \$223,610 for the grant period of February 6, 2009 through September 30, 2009; Somerset Academy High School South Campus in the amount of \$200,265 for the grant period of March 6, 2009, through September 30, 2009; and Somerset Academy Middle School South Campus, in the amount of \$240,174 for the grant period of March 6, 2009, through September 30, 2009;
- 3. retain funds from the grants in an amount not to exceed the annually negotiated indirect cost rate, as allowed and approved by the FLDOE;
- extend these programs as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program; and
- 5. direct Financial Services to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
