Michael has a passion for music and a determination to serve others. In addition to serving as the Coral Reef Senior High School Marching Band Drum Major, for the past two years Michael has been part of LIFO Missions and has traveled to the mountains of the Dominican Republic to build aqueducts that allow running water to reach a community in need. As he believes that music is a crucial part of the Dominican culture, he has obtained donations of traditional Dominican instruments to distribute within the communities. He will be attending Florida State University where his goal is to obtain a degree in music business and performance.
