The Donaldsons established the organization out of a concern that many Americans were unaware of a highly significant and vital part of our history. Their collaborative vision led to the development of exhibits and the Mobile African-American Museum, which provides an effective and efficient way to share African history at schools and other locations.

To provide students an opportunity to participate in academic competitions, Kinad, Inc. developed the brain bowl academic competition. The competition allows Miami-Dade County Public School students the opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge of subject areas such as science, government, chemistry, mathematics, and African-American history.

Kinad, Inc. has received numerous honors from local, state, and community agencies and organizations and was awarded the prestigious Pillars Award for community service by the Miami-Dade County Black Affairs Advisory Board. The organization has shared its message at more than 250 locations locally and statewide and its traveling display was exhibited in the rotunda of the State Capitol in Tallahassee, where more than 15,000 visitors shared the experience.
