Authorization is requested to accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) in the approximate amount of \$1,216,653, to fund the Title II, Part D, Enhancing Education Through Technology (EETT) program for the grant period of July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010. This federal-through-state grant award is an entitlement allocation based on the proportion of Title I, Part A funding received by the District. The EETT grant program is designed to ensure that all students have equitable access to modern technology-based instructional tools and quality educational content. The grant, managed by the Division of Instructional Technology, supports the District's efforts to provide students with the necessary skills so that they are able to successfully compete in a global economy. Additionally, the grant helps sustain the District's goal of recruiting, developing and retaining high-performing, diverse, and motivated faculty and staff.

The EETT allocation for 2008-2009 was \$1,294,937; this year's allocation of \$1,216,653 represents a 6 percent decrease. No matching funds are required as a condition to receive this grant funding. Grant funds will be used for substitute coverage for districtwide technology professional development, six full-time positions, hourly salaries of Miami-Dade Virtual School teachers, licensing of course content for the Miami-Dade Virtual School, travel, and supplies.

Official notification of this grant award is anticipated on or before September 1, 2009. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective July 1, 2009.
