On July 11, 2007, the Board commissioned Adviron Environmental Systems, Inc. (AES), to provide Environmental Consulting and Testing Services (EC&TS) for a four-year term, with the second, third and fourth years at the option of the Board.

To date, for the second year of the Agreement a total of \$88,846 has been paid to AES. The third-year option will begin on July 11, 2009, and expire on July 10, 2010 under the same terms and conditions.

The most recent overall performance evaluation score issued by staff to the firm was for the period ending May 18, 2009. Based on a performance scale of 1-5, AES received 4.38.

Based on the above information, staff recommends authorization to exercise the third-year option of the Agreement with AES for EC&TS under the same terms and conditions.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent, or his designee, to exercise the third-year option with Adviron Environmental Systems, Inc., to provide Environmental Consulting and Testing Services for Facilities in Regions 2, 4 and 6, under the same terms and conditions.
