On August 26, 2009, the following letter was sent to Mr. Freddie L. Robinson, Jr.:

This is to notify you that the Superintendent of Schools will be recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of September 9, 2009, that the School Board suspend you without pay from your current position as Teacher at Lawton Chiles Middle School, for three workdays, effective at the close of the workday, September 9, 2009, for just cause, including, but not limited to: misconduct in office; and violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13- 4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties, 6Gx13- 4A-1.213, Code of Ethics, and 6Gx13- 5D-1.07, Corporal Punishment-Prohibited. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 1001.32(2), 1012.22(1)(f), and 447.209, Florida Statutes; and State Board Rules 6B-1.001 and 6B-1.006 (3)(a)(3)(f).

If the School Board accepts (or approves) the Superintendent's recommendation, you will be notified of the School Board's action.

You have waived, in writing, your right to an administrative hearing.

RECOMMENDED: That effective September 9, 2009, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend Mr. Freddie L. Robinson, Jr., Teacher at Lawton Chiles Middle School, for three workdays without pay.
