SUBJECT: THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA v. KENNETH MILLS - DOAH CASE NO. 08-5491

On October 15, 2008, the School Board took action to suspend and initiate dismissal proceedings against Kenneth Mills, a teacher with the District, for misconduct in office and violations of School Board Rules 6Gx13- 4A-1.21, *Responsibilities and Duties*; and 6Gx13- 4A-1.213 *Code of Ethics*. Respondent requested an administrative hearing, which was held on March 30, 2009 before Administrative Law Judge J.D. Parrish.

By Recommended Order entered July 20, 2009, the Administrative Law Judge recommended that the School Board enter a final order terminating Respondent's employment.

A copy of the Recommended Order is being furnished to the Board under separate cover, along with a copy of the proposed Final Order for the Board's consideration.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida enter a Final Order accepting the Recommended Order of the Administrative Law Judge in the case of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida v. Kenneth Mills, DOAH Case No. 08-5491, terminating Respondent's employment.
