On September 30, 2009, the following letter was sent to Mr. Keith Goa:

This is to notify you that the Superintendent of Schools will be recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of October 14, 2009, that the School Board suspend you without pay from your current position as Security Monitor at Broadmoor Elementary School for 10 workdays, effective at the close of the workday, October 14, 2009, for just cause, including, but not limited to: violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13- 4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties; and 6Gx13- 4A-1.213, Code of Ethics. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 1001.32(2), 1012.22(1)(f), and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

If the School Board accepts (or approves) the Superintendent's recommendation, you will be notified of the School Board's action.

You have waived, in writing, your right to contest your suspension.

RECOMMENDED: That effective October 14, 2009, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend Mr. Keith Goa, Security Monitor at Broadmoor Elementary School, for 10 workdays without pay.
