Contract No. 105-JJ10 – TITLE I SUPPLEMENTARY INSTRUCTIONAL AND SUPPORT SERVICES FOR NON-PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS (REBID), is to provide supplementary instructional and support services in the areas of reading, writing, and mathematics, to Title I eligible students enrolled in non-public schools, as well as professional development and parental involvement activities in support of these students, their teachers and families, during the term of the contract, effective August 5, 2009, through June 30, 2010. The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) provided additional funds for Local Educational Agencies (LEAs), to support the purpose and intent of the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB) under Title I, Part A. This supplemental amount of up to \$1,400,000 represents the equitable portion for the participation of children attending non-public schools under ARRA, as required by NCLB. } Revised
