SUBJECT: THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA v. BRENT RICH - DOAH CASE NO. 09-1065

On February 11, 2009, the School Board took action to suspend and initiate dismissal proceedings against Brent Rich, a school security monitor with the District, for violations of School Board Rules 6Gx13- 4A-1.01, *Equal Opportunity Employment and Assignment*; 6Gx13- 4A-1.21, *Responsibilities and Duties*; and 6Gx13- 4A-1.213, *Code of Ethics*. Respondent requested an administrative hearing, which was held on August 3, 2009 before Administrative Law Judge Claude B. Arrington.

By Recommended Order entered October 19, 2009, the Administrative Law Judge recommended that the School Board enter a final order terminating Respondent's employment.

A copy of the Recommended Order is being furnished to the Board under separate cover, along with a copy of the proposed Final Order for the Board's consideration.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida enter a Final Order accepting the Recommended Order of the Administrative Law Judge in the case of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida v. Brent Rich, DOAH Case No. 09-1065, terminating Respondent's employment.
