As established in School Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.471, Charter Schools (K-12), Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) has received charter school applications from individuals and/or organizations in the community.

On December 2, 2009, M-DCPS' Charter School District Review Committee met to review the application for Franklin Academy - A and, by a unanimous vote, made a recommendation for approval of the application to the Superintendent of Schools.

The charter school proposes to serve a maximum of 1,340 students in Kindergarten through grade eight in a single gender, co-educational setting, with a maximum of 750 students in Kindergarten through grade six in its first year of operation, commencing with the 2010-2011 school year and continuing throughout the term of the contract, which ends on June 30, 2015, and concludes in the 2014-2015 school year.

Following is the Founding Board for the charter school: Dr. David L. Thomas, Professor and Chairman, Department of Surgery, Nova Southeastern College of Osteopathic Medicine; Mr. Terry Maus, Consultant; and Mr. Mark Grimmel, Insurance Agent and President of Egis Insurance & Risk Advisors.

The charter school contractual agreement will be submitted for School Board consideration at a subsequent meeting at which time there will be a public hearing to provide for community input.
