Authorization is requested to accept two grant awards from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE), in the total amount of approximately \$450,000, for funding under the 2008-2011 Public Charter School Grant Program for the grant period of September 23, 2009 through July 31, 2010, for Somerset Academy Elementary School (South Miami), in the amount of \$225,000, and Somerset Academy Middle School (South Miami) in the amount of \$225,000, for the grant period of September 23, 2009, through July 31, 2010.

The FLDOE issued a Request for Applications under the 2008-2011 Public Charter School Grant Program for the purpose of awarding grants to charter schools partnering with local educational agencies in order to provide a high quality education for all Grant funds will be used to support planning, program design and implementation activities and to supplement the level of funds that would be made available from non-federal sources

In accordance with the FLDOE grant guidelines, Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) must be the fiscal agent on behalf of each of the charter schools that receives such grants. The Board's approval of the recommended action would not constitute an endorsement of the grant or its intended use. It would merely satisfy the Board's requirement under Florida Statutes, Section 1002.33, Charter Schools, which requires that M-DCPS serve as the fiscal agent.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive the grant funding. Grant funds in the amount of \$450,000, will be distributed as follows:

Official notification of these grant awards was received on October 23, 2009, which is after the start of the grant periods. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective September 23, 2009, for the respective grant programs.

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept two grant awards from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the 2008-2011 Public Charter School Grant Program, in the approximate amount of \$450,000;
- 2. disburse grant funds in the approximate amount of \$447,006, to Somerset Academy Elementary (South Miami), in the amount of \$224,325, for the grant period of September 23, 2009, through July 31, 2010, and Somerset Academy Middle (South Miami), in the amount of \$222,681, for the period of September 23, 2009, through July 31, 2010;
- 3. retain funds from the grants in an amount not to exceed the annually negotiated indirect cost rate, as allowed and approved by the FLDOE;
- extend these programs as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program; and
- 5. direct Financial Services to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
