SUBJECT: THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA v. JUDITH GREY, DOAH Case No. 10-9324

On September 8, 2010, the School Board took action to suspend Judith Grey, a Teacher with Miami-Dade County Public Schools, without pay for thirty (30) workdays for just cause including, but not limited to, violations of School Board Rules 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties and 6Gx13-4A-1.213, Code of Ethics. Ms. Grey timely requested an administrative hearing. The final hearing was held on December 16, 2010 before the Division of Administrative Hearings. At the conclusion of the case, the Administrative Law Judge submitted an Order recommending that the School Board sustain the thirty (30) work day suspension.

Administration is in agreement with the conclusions of the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order. Sustaining Ms. Grey's suspension is in the best interest of the School Board. A copy of the Recommended Order is being furnished to the Board under separate cover.

RECOMMENDED:

That the School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, adopt the recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge and enter a Final Order in the case of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida v. Judith Grey , DOAH Case No. 10-9324 suspending Respondent without pay for thirty (30) work days.
