This contract was awarded by the Board on February 10, 2010, to purchase, at firm unit prices, quantities, as may be required, of plastic can liners, for Stores and Mail Distribution stock.

Subsequent to the award, deliveries of plastic can liners from All American Poly, of Piscataway, New Jersey, Calico Industries, Inc., of Annapolis Junction, Maryland, and Peninsular Paper Company Central Florida, Inc., of Winter Park, Florida, failed to meet specifications. Therefore, the recommendation reflects the termination of All American Poly, Calico Industries, Inc. and Peninsular Paper Company Central Florida, Inc. as awardees on Contract No. 099-JJ02 and the loss of eligibility to transact new business with the Board for a period of fourteen (14) months, pursuant to School Board Policy 6320 – Purchasing.
