Seven days are required for this trip, none of which are school days. Travel will be provided by either Delta, Iberia, Continental or American Airlines.

The students and chaperones participating in the trip will be registered with the U.S. Department of State by utilizing their on-line Smart Traveler Enrollment Program (STEP) which is a free service provided by the United States Government. By registering trip participants with STEP, the Department of State can better assist them in an emergency.
