RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept grant awards for two programs from:
 - a. Corporation for Public Broadcasting under the Television Community Service Grant in the approximate amount of \$1,272,757, for the grant period of October 1, 2011, through September 30, 2013; and
 - b. Corporation for Public Broadcasting under the Radio Community Services Grant in the approximate amount of \$626,768, for the grant period of October 1, 2011, through September 30, 2013.
- 2. extend these programs as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program;
- 3. retain funds from the grant in an amount not to exceed the probably negotiated indirect cost rate, as allowed and approved by the FLDOE;
- 4. direct Financial Services to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board; and
- 5. authorize travel out-of-state as required by the grant parameters.
