Robin brought home gold in the 1600 meter medley relay and the 400 meter.

The dynamic 16-year-old was named the 2010 Female Athlete of the Year by The Miami Herald. She won the 100-, 200-, and 400-meter races at the 2009 USA Youth Outdoor Championship. Robin also has two gold medals in the 200- and 400-meter and long jump from the 2009 USA Junior Olympics. She is the 2010 Florida High School State champion in the 100- and 400-meter as well as the long jump. She holds seven Class 3A state track individual championship titles, which is a state record.

Robin led her school team to a state track championship in her freshman year. In addition, she runs for the Miami Northwest Express Track Club. She is a well-rounded athlete who plays volleyball, basketball and runs cross-country track. In addition to athletics, Robin enjoys poetry and composing music in her spare time. She currently holds a 3.45 grade point average.
