

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-035

RECOGNIZING THE MIAMI ALUMNAE CHAPTER OF DELTA SIGMA THETA

WHEREAS, the Miami Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority has a rich history of community service for the past 70 years; and

WHEREAS, founded in 1941, the active chapter has created programs and projects that serve the Miami community. The chapter's 320 members advocate aggressive public service initiatives to affect positive social change; and

WHEREAS, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. is the largest African-American Greek-lettered sorority in the United States with more than 200,000 members and approximately 950 chapters around the world; and

WHEREAS, the Miami Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority is known for its signature events, such as the Debutante program, Jabberwock and the Poinsettia Gala; and

WHEREAS, Project Vision partners with Miami-Dade County Public Schools to provide computer tutoring, mentoring and personal development seminars. The organization also tutors more than 150 students in Carol City in subjects including math, reading and standardized test preparation; and

WHEREAS, the Miami Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority is to be commended for its valuable public service to the Miami community;
