TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, AND MATHEMATICS (STEM), INCLUDING A FUNDING PARTNERSHIP UNDER MUTUALLY ACCEPTABLE TERMS AND CONDITIONS, AS WELL AS A POTENTIAL COLLABORATION WITH MIAMI-DADE COLLEGE, INCLUDING GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

District staff has been in preliminary discussions with the City of Miami Overtown Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) over a potential collaboration to rebuild Frederick Douglass Elementary School as a new K-8 Center with an enhanced program focusing on Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM). CRA officials have preliminarily indicated a willingness to advance funding for the project and to share in the cost of the new facility, under mutually acceptable terms and conditions; including a willingness by the CRA to consider deferral of payments for the Board's share to accommodate the District's capital funding constraints. Additionally, a potential collaboration with Miami-Dade College including grant opportunities would also be explored.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to explore a collaboration with the City of Miami Overtown Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) to rebuild Frederick Douglass Elementary School as a K-8 with a programmatic focus on Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM), including a funding partnership under mutually acceptable terms and conditions, as well as a potential collaboration with Miami-Dade College, including grant opportunities.
