SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION TO PAY CONSTRUCTION CONNECTION CHARGES REQUIRED BY THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF WATER FACILITIES TO SERVICE MAYS MIDDLE SCHOOL PROJECT NO. 00976300

In order for the District to provide fire protection services to the auditorium at Mays Middle School, located at 11700 SW 216 Street, the District will install a new 6-inch water main, which will be interconnected to an existing 12-inch water main on SW 117 Avenue, owned by the Miami-Dade County Water and Sewer Department (County). Connection to the existing 12-inch water main will require the Board to pay to the County a pro-rata share of the initial cost to construct the 12-inch water main. The County has advised that this construction connection charge will be in an amount not to exceed \$23,805.40. Funding for this work is available, as follows:
