SUBJECT: THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA v. MICHAEL MOSAKU-DOAH CASE NO. 11-4750

On September 7, 2011, the School Board suspended Michael Mosaku, a Miami-Dade County Public Schools teacher, and initiated dismissal proceedings against him for just cause, including, but not limited to misconduct in office and violation of School Board Rule 6Gx13- 4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties, 6Gx13-4-1.09, Employee-Student Relationships, and 6Gx13-4A-1.213, Code of Ethics, in accordance with sections 1001.32(2), 1012.22(1)(f), 1012.33(1)(a) and (6)(a), and 447.209, Florida Statutes and the United Teachers of Dade collective bargaining agreement. After the Respondent timely requested a hearing, but before the evidentiary hearing actually took place, Respondent tendered his letter of resignation on January 4, 2012.

Upon consultation with administration, it is recommended that the Board enter a Final Order accepting Respondent's resignation.
