**SUBJECT: PROPERTY TAXES**

In recent weeks media outlets have given coverage to allegations regarding rampant property tax fraud in Miami-Dade County in connection with homestead exemption claims.

By some accounts, this type of fraud could be costing local governments in Miami-Dade County nearly \$200 million a year in revenues. Approximately one-third of this total represents revenues that would otherwise flow into Miami-Dade County Public Schools' capital budget.

Beyond our disconcerting deferred maintenance schedule that a recovery of these funds would help allay, it is the responsibility of all governments to ensure that tax policies are being enforced across the board.

MR. CARLOS L. CURBELO:**

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, direct the Superintendent to meet with local stakeholders such as the State Attorney, the Property Tax Appraiser, and others to devise a mechanism by which to investigate allegations of broad property tax fraud in Miami-Dade County.
